

Students will be able to experience an authentic workplace environment by applying the methodologies and practices of real-world developers, and acquire skills around teamwork, problem-solving, collaboration, and communication.

The 22 boys on the high school track team had a very successful season. The Bulldogs placed well as a team in 5 of their invitationals. At the Cumberland Invite the finish was 5th out of 10 teams, at Newton the finish was a 4th place tie out of 15 teams, at the Altamont Open we finished 2nd out of 10 teams, and finished 3rd out of 23 teams in the Shelbyville open. The Bulldogs also placed 2nd at the National Trail Conference meet.

At the Sectional in Altamont, the team finished 3rd overall and advanced 5 people to the State track meet. Brian Dust qualified in the 800m run. Jack Elder qualified in the 110M Hurdles, 300M Hurdles, and the 200M Dash. He finished 7th place in the state in the 300M Hurdles. The 3200M Relay team of Ty Wiedman, Brian Dust, Noah Tegler, and Ollie Kingery also qualified.

Lastly, 2 relay teams broke schools records that have been in place since 1979. Drew Dust, Mick Willenborg, Kennan Walsh and Jack Elder broke the 400M Relay record. The 800M relay was broken by Jack Elder, Mick Willenborg, Ty Wiedman, and Kennan Walsh.

Alumni Spotlight

Kyle Wente ('99)

Kyle Wente graduated from St. Anthony High school in 1999. In high school, he was a First Team All- State Basketball player. He continued his education and basketball career at Princeton University, where he earned a degree in Economics and was Captain of the varsity basketball team. After graduating, Kyle worked for Merrill Lynch in New York City where he worked with fellow St. Anthony alumnus John Hartke in the Mergers & Acquisitions group. He left Merrill Lynch just before the 2008 financial crisis to join private equity firm Platte River Equity in Denver, CO. Here he partnered with business owners to invest in and grow mid-sized companies in the natural resources and energy services industries. It was through this work with business owners that Kyle came to recognize and appreciate his favorite attribute of the St. Anthony community - its entrepreneurial blood. "I believe the St. Anthony community is unique to have so many successful entrepreneurs who are committed to their business, their church and their community. I have always felt a pull to follow that example and live up to a certain expectation."

With this realization, Kyle committed to becoming a business owner himself. He then earned an MBA at Northwestern's Kellogg School of Management and began searching for a business he could grow and that would align with his values. In 2015 he acquired EcoEnclose (www.ecoenclose.com), a packaging business that supplies environmentally thoughtful solutions for thousands of ecommerce businesses in the US and internationally. Kyle and his wife, Saloni, run the business which is located in Louisville, CO. With their three kids, they live in Niwot, CO, a small community about 40 minutes north of Denver, CO.
