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## **Scholarship Guidelines:**

- Scholarships are to be awarded to incoming freshman students attending St. Anthony High School, whom did not advance from St. Anthony Grade School. The incoming freshman must be registered and accepted at SAHS.
- 2. The goal of the program is to award the maximum of two scholarships to any one grade school/junior high.
- 3. The Jim and Kay Jansen Outreach Scholarship shall **COVER ALL 4 YEARS OF TUITION** and fees (housing expenses not included), for EACH of the six recipients.
- 4. Donor committee is to award scholarships with information provided by, and requested from SAHS administration. (Parental financial information will not be provided to the donor committee.)
- 5. Scholarships will have a financial need based component.
- 6. Recipients must maintain a minimum 2.5 GPA annually to retain scholarship commitment.
- 7. Recipients must adhere to school policies, any on or off campus drug charges would discontinue the scholarship. Expulsion would discontinue the scholarship.



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
